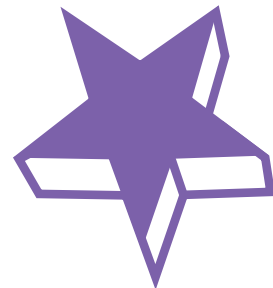
Why get involved?
